

Last month, I had planned a number of visits, but came down with bronchitis. Out the window went my calendar! He has helped me get back to some visits in the last week of September and into



October. Hopefully I can again lead the Bible studies in facilities for those who live there and enjoy coming.

These holidays create good themes for Bible study lessons, whether it be gratitude or wonder at God's plan to bring salvation through Jesus' coming to earth. Please pray the Lord will use me to share the Good News of great joy these days represent. And pray those who hear will respond with all their hearts to His invitation for a relationship with Him.
