any of the struggles we see In the Bible relate to *timing*. God is not bound by time; but, as humans, we are. As we serve Him, we need to respect that our view of time needs to be subject to God's plan. Galatians 4:4 begins with the phrase, "But when the time had *fully come...* " These simple words imply that whatever was about

to happen was happening at that time for a reason. We can further extrapolate that, if that event happened at a different time, it would not have been as beneficial. What was the event that Paul was writing about in this section of his letter to the Galatians? Something minor perhaps? No, it was the most major event in human history outside of creation: the coming of Jesus Christ into the world.

God carefully planned the coming of Christ. He paid very special attention to the timing of His arrival on earth. Jesus could have done this great thing at any time in history, but God chose that specific time. God knew that, at that moment in history, Jesus could make the most impact on the world.

I have been guilty of having very human time expectations for the H\*VMI Property Project. If I ran the universe and wrote a letter to the supporters of H\*VMI like the one Paul wrote to the Galatians, I would start it by saying, "The time has fully come... for the H\*VMI property to be up and running, hosting camping programs, training events, Bible clubs and other outreaches." I would write that the time has fully come to serve more people than ever, shining the light of the Gospel to our community. In my human understanding, I can see no reason that

these things should not be happening right now, or a year ago, or two years ago. But, thank the Lord, for the sake of all humanity, that I am not God. I do not have the big picture. I am very simply a piece of God's puzzle. God is all knowing, loving and more wonderful than we can imagine and He has a plan. We simply need to trust Him in it and be sure that, at every turn, in every step of the process, we are glorifying Him. We also need to be sure that we are striving toward what we believe God's will is for our lives and our ministry.

At the beginning of the summer, my human timeline was the following: finish preparing for submission of the Land

Development Plan by mid to late summer, secure that approval by fall, begin fundraising, begin site

work and construction by winter, continue raising funds; and, we're off to the races! God had a different plan. Through our final stages of the engineering and planning process, we discovered that the topography and building design made it necessary to move the location of the new driveway entrance. We could not have been aware of this prior to the detailed level of planning that takes place in this near final approval phase. Unfortunately, this caused a discrepancy between the nearly completed Land Development Plan and one of the conditions from the Conditional Use Hearing. As a result, we must go back and change/remove that condition. There is no undo button, no legal eraser, even for something as simple as a

driveway re-location. We must go through a Conditional Use Hearing once more to request that the condition that pertains to moving our driveway be changed or removed. This impacts our timeline and increases it by at least three to four months.

This is, obviously, disappointing news to all of us. I should say all of us—except for God. Why? Why isn't He disappointed that we are delayed in the process of actively serving Him on the new property in Akron? For the same reason He wasn't disappointed that Jesus didn't come to earth in Noah's time or when Moses was born or when Esther was approaching the king or at the time of the judges. Because the time had not and has not yet fully come. We can't see or understand the reasoning; but God is not thrown off or disappointed by this and we should not be either. We need to continue to look to Him for guidance and strength through the times when we struggle because the future is not here yet. And, we need to seek to serve Him as best we can in our current positions and with our current resources.

In 1 Corinthians and 2 Timothy, Paul references the Christian life, comparing it to a race. Trusting in God's timing isn't simply sitting back and watching the world go by. We need to run! We need to strive toward what God has for us. For those of you following the H\*VMI Property Project, you may have hoped that this race would be a sprint; but it is turning out to be a marathon. If we're being transparent and hold to the metaphor, we would say it's a marathon with hurdles and some surprise left turns! However, the length of the race should not negatively affect our perception of the outcome. When we think about the different types of runners, who do you think desires the finish line more: a sprinter who runs 100 yards in 10-11 seconds or the marathon runner who has been on his or her feet for 2-3 hours? That finish line is far sweeter for the long distance runner who has had all that time through the struggle and pain to imagine what completing the long journey will be like.

We are all in this long distance race together. Keep looking with me to the finish line. God is there, and He knows how sweet it will be.



or those of you who have been following my Associate Missionary adventure, it has been quite a journey! 
