PROPERTY UPDATE:

W ith so much closure and cancellation all around us, it may be hard to think toward the future, to see the light at the end of this tunnel. To be very frank, a large part of our time at the ministry through the most restrictive quarantine months has been, heads down, trying to re-engineer a socially distanced ministry wheel. God has allowed amazing success in these efforts as you will read in this issue of *Increase*.

Through it all, we have been toiling in the background not only planning and executing the amazing H*VMI ministry that has been taking place during COVID-19 challenges, but making sure we spend time thinking forward and planning for the future. "What is the future of H*VMI?" you ask. When the H*VMI property is completed and in full swing, the possibilities are amazing, such as opportunities for growth and expansion of existing programs and more options for training the local church. Through this growing and changing, the mission of H*VMI will stay the same. Our drive to serve is as fervent as ever. However, when we complete construction, we will be "cancelling" some things:

• Rental payments

These funds will instead go to the upkeep of our own Ministry Center.

Wooden ramps

These will be replaced by buildings designed for accessibility.

- Schedules that aren't our own The schedules of our rental facilities will no longer impact the way we do ministry.
- Limitations on who we serve Formerly we could not serve some people who came our way due to capacity and

weekly limitations, or health reasons due to facilities not having AC or other needed amenities. Our ministry center is designed to address those needs.

Cancelling or Constructing

> For too many summers we have packed and moved, packed and moved and packed and moved again. Once we move our ministry supplies to the property, we won't need another moving truck!

With all the shutdowns, cancellations and postponements, what HAS been done to further progress in preparation for construction at the H*VMI Property in Akron, PA? We had already secured our second Conditional Use decision which allows our second driveway to be in the best location. As you may have guessed, COVID-19 related shutdowns really hampered our ability to have in-person meetings with or to get responses from government agencies. However, the H*VMI team, engineer and board members have been meeting both virtually and in person as we were able. We have developed a Storm Water Management Plan. The finishing touches are being put on our Land Development Plan that will be submitted to the borough for review. Timing is in God's Hands. We discuss it quite often as a staff and board. We are aiming for approvals to be finalized in fall 2020, and due to fall/winter freezing temps, our official ground breaking in early spring 2021. We have seen God's guiding Hand through all of this. His timing is predominant and He is in perfect control. For now, we press on and wait anxiously for the day when we can CANCEL the challenges we have faced being a ministry without a permanent home by CONSTRUCTING our ministry center.

New \$300 Universal Charitable Deduction

To help alleviate the economic devastation caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Congress has enacted the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). The Cares Act is a brandnew universal deduction for charitable contributions. Taxpayers who don't itemize may now deduct up to \$300 per year in charitable contributions given to a 501(c)(3) public charity.

No Annual Limit on 2020 Charitable **Deduction by Itemizers**

For 2020 only, if you itemize, the CARES Act allows a taxpayer to deduct contributions up to 100% instead of 60% of their Adjusted Gross Income and wipe out your income tax liability entirely.

Contributions by Corporations

The CARES Act increases these amounts to 25% of taxable income for 2020. Donations of more than 25% may be deducted in the following five years.

Please consult your financial advisor or tax professional to see if you are able to access these advantages. These changes are limited to 2020.

We're praying that the virus will soon be under control and that social justice truly will prevail under the guidance of the One Who created every man and woman, white, black, brown, red, yellow.... Perhaps when these things happen, the Cancel Culture will be able to look different than it does today. Perhaps some things that have been CANCELLED will be fully or, at least, partially restored.

Colossians 2:13-14 speaks to an ETERNAL CANCELLATION. "When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having CANCELLED OUT the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross."
