LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS

cry to escape the despair and uncertainties of this world seems to grow louder each day. There is a kind of "darkness" overwhelming so many lives. Perhaps yours is one of those "lives." You've already been wounded by the death of your child. And now you're living in the strange world of a pandemic. Do I hear your cry? See your tears? Sense your despair because of dark days?

David also experienced dark days and events. Throughout the Psalms, we read his cries for relief. They are so reassuring.

David experienced the death of several children. You know the stories: when he sinned greatly against God, the consequence for him was to experience the horrible ache of losing the child he and Bathsheba conceived. And, he lost his son, Chileab, thought to be very young when he died. And, his son, Absalom, killed his half-brother, another of David's sons, Amnon. And, Absalom also rebelled against his father and was, ultimately, killed himself. In addition to losing several children, David had earlier been pursued by Saul who wanted to kill David. And, as if that weren't enough, he had ongoing wars with the Philistines. How much darkness can a person bear?

David needed something to light up the darkness of his world, brought about by the incredible pain of losing

several children; by attempts on his own life; and by constant wars. He found what he needed in God, His Savior. In 2 Samuel 22:29 he wrote, *"For You are my* lamp, LORD; And the LORD illuminates my darkness."

We all long for the "light at the end of the tunnel" to give us hope that a break in the darkness of our despair is coming. More than that light, tho', we need light that shines on the path that leads us straight to God. Two things will help us as we're walking that path: 1) the faithfulness of God and 2) our choice to trust in His faithfulness.

Recently, I reread an entry in the amazing book, Valley of Vision. An excerpt follows. I pray that it will encourage your heart, as it did mine, as you seek light in the darkness:

Lord, in the daytime stars can be seen from deepest wells. And the deeper the wells the brighter Thy stars shine; Let me find Thy light in my darkness, Thy life in my death, Thy joy in my sorrow, Thy grace in my sin, Thy riches in my poverty, Thy glory in my (dark) valley.*

I have always been a good one for fixing things myself! I like to be busy, to be doing all I can, all the time. But of course there is no way I can control sickness, accident or death. But He, in His wisdom, controls all things, allows the trials and tragedies in our lives. How often He speaks to my heart, telling me not to try to work things out—but instead just to "trust in Him." Praise the Lord that Jesus never fails.

One day as I was on my way to the hospital where I was doing volunteer work and involved with those who needed chemotherapy, the thought of death was much on my mind. I was also helping at hospice at the time, so I suppose it was nature for the thoughts of death to frequently be on the front of my mind. I suddenly asked myself, "and what if death comes to your house?" My quick response was, "Get thee behind me, Satan!" But almost as quickly II Corinthians 12:9 came to my mind: *"My grace is sufficient for thee."* It was just two weeks later that my seventeen-year-old son was suddenly taken home in an accident on the way home from a Bible study.

Since that day the Lord has continued to bring Scripture verses to my mind that meet the need I have at that time. I was reminded over and over again that I do need to trust in the Lord with ALL my heart and acknowledge Him in ALL my ways. I live with the realization that my son is indeed "Safe in the Arms of Jesus."


