How God Changed My Life

n October 5, 2016 a phone call came to our home that a parent never expects to receive. My wife answered the phone. I heard the tone of her voice. I will never forget it. "He's what?"

He was just thirty years old but our son, Andy, is no longer with us. Never again will I, his father, watch a him or say, "I love you." I began to wonder, "What will this do to my wife?" "Is our faith strong enough to get us through this?" "How do we move on?"

I want to share a few things that happened to us in the first couple of weeks: our pastor came to our house the very next morning. He shared some Scripture with us and prayed for us. We asked him some questions. Some were answered and some were not. We were in shock. Phone calls started coming in. Food was brought in. I remember not being hungry. We started making funeral arrangements. As soon as we walked into our home, returning from talking with the funeral director, there was a knock on our sliding glass doors. Outside the doors stood our home group from church. They came in and told us that we didn't have to say a thing. They just wanted to be with us and pray with us. What a blessing. I remember that some of the prayers were for the driver of the tractor trailer that had killed our son. At that point, so new in our grief, Phyllis and I had not thought about him. The prayers of our home group reminded us that this man is also one of God's creations, and God

loves all whom He has created. One morning, my wife was not having a good morning. There was a knock on the door. Geri was there with a chocolate cake with peanut butter icing—a Steinman favorite. She sat with my wife and told her that she had lost her husband very suddenly. She understood some of how my wife felt. My wife's day was better after that. Another blessing.

Nancy, another bereaved mom from church, came alongside my wife and took her to a BASIS meeting. From that point on God started to change my heart and mind. Eventually, Nancy, my wife, Phyllis, and I started a BASIS support group in the Paradise PA area. This group now comes together monthly to care about, pray for and help each other as we each face the death of our children. It's a safe place to cry as well as learn of God's hope and joy for us. We have a God of mercy and He does give us much-needed grace.

I have now retired from my job and am serving fulltime in the H*VMI/BASIS ministry. I am learning so much and love what I am doing, which is helping other hurting parents and offering resources to pastors so they can minister to those in their congregation who are grieving. It's all for God's glory.

God has the perfect plan for each and every one of us. Sometimes the plans feel good and sometimes His plans for us are painful and challenging. Yes, our son is no longer with us, but he is in our hearts and in God's Hands.
