That's why BASIS is so vital to grieving parents. It is one of the ways in which God reveals Himself in times of trouble. I am thankful for that in my own life.

In ANY times of trouble, God is always the "first responder." He reveals His presence through people who provide love, care and help of all kinds. What a privilege to be the heart, hands, feet, ears and voice of God to people around us who are hurting.

Progress on New Property

You have probably been hearing and reading about H*VMI's property project. We are excited about the way God is leading us "Step by Step" towards a permanent ministry center. This would allow H*VMI to invest all funds in its services and outreaches instead of spending it on rental facilities. The ministry center will provide a permanent place for current ministries to continue and for ministry expansion.

BASIS is a ministry that is close to my heart. My wife and I have gone through two miscarriages and had some very difficult complications with the second that resulted in a second surgical procedure and a very tough time of grieving for our family. The leadership at H*VMI sees your hurt and your need



as BASIS parents and we have been planning this property project with you in mind. We have planned for comfortable meeting rooms for fellowship and support group meetings. We have designed sleeping facilities with private rooms for retreats and for get-aways for parents who have lost children. Some of us can't afford to, or have a hard time getting away, during those difficult times of the year. We hope you'll continue to pray with us as we pursue what God has for us with this property.

Parents Share



A fter the death of our sixteen year old son, devastation fell upon us. We walked numbly through each day—each day filled with loneliness and despair. God seemed to be far away, and there were those days when I didn't know what or how to pray.

God had promised never to leave or forsake us. Where was He now? What were we to do now that He had taken our only son? What would fill the place of the care I had given for so many years? How could this terrible load of loneliness ever be lifted?

I didn't want to feel that the pain was mine. I wanted immediate deliverance. In this day of instant everything, it was a hard lesson to learn—that I had to be patient and wait on the Lord.

In those days and weeks of loneliness, God took me under His wing, protecting me. When I cried, "Why?" I came to realize that God had watched His own Son die on a cross for my sins. Was I worthy to have Someone die for me? God knew the heartache and pain I felt because, He, too, had watched His only Son die. How gracious and longsuffering our God is. When we cry out, He doesn't turn His back on us. He loves and wants us to wait quietly until we hear that still small voice filled with comfort and peace.

God did have a purpose in all we went through, although it took me a long time to see that. I told Him I needed something to take up the hours I had devoted to caring for Jimmie. He provided a job as a special education aide in our school system. I've found fulfillment with these children who so need love and attention. Does it take the place of my son? No! But God has given me an answer to prayer so that my days are filled with a purpose and a means of easing the loneliness.
