uring my fifth month of pregnancy, my husband and I were informed that the child I was carrying would be stillborn, or live but a few hours. This was my first deep, personal grief and was quickly followed by the news that my mother-in-law was dying of cancer!

One of the greatest helps to me in facing my sorrow was the supportive relationships with friends. Oh, the comfort of those who were able to weep with us. I came home from the doctor's office and called my best friend. She listened. She cried with me and we prayed together. She frequently called and let me spend time with her as I needed to.

Another friend, who had lost her son, truly understood how I felt and assured me that my feelings of anger were normal. She encouraged me to pour out my heart to the Lord. When I said, "I can't believe I'm getting fat like this for nothing," she didn't tell me not to feel that way. Instead she assured me of her prayers and support.

This friend also set up a pen-pal relationship with a young mother who a short time before had experienced a similar pregnancy and stillbirth. This mother answered many specific questions and gave me hope that, with time, I too would know God's healing of my pain.

From these special friends, I learned the valuable lesson of giving comfort to others. Before my loss I was unaware of the intense pain of grief. Now I saw first-hand what it was like, and how the Lord ministered to me through these sisters in Christ. Now I've been able to share with another young mother who also lost her newborn. What a privilege to pass on the comfort that had been given me.
