and harmony into situate and relationships. The opposite, falsehood, is accomplished through self-centered focus that is demanding and demeaning, producing sure and certain destruction to all whom it touches.

By Tim Sheetz, The difference H*VMI Founder and Ministry Ambassador, BASIS Support Group Leader between truth and falsehood is represented so well in this brief text through two men, Diotrephes and Demetrius. Diotrephes is described in verse 9 as a man who "... loves to be first among them and does not accept what we say." John goes on to say in verse 10, "....I will call attention to his deeds which he does, unjustly accusing us with wicked words; and not satisfied, neither does he himself receive the brethren, and he forbids those who desire to do so, and puts them out of the church." It's apparent that this man is intent on his own desires and goals not caring about others, using falsehood as a vehicle through which he brings hurt and disunity. Just reading these words about Diotrephes makes me uncomfortable.

We see the opposite in the life of Demetrius.

Look at verse 12. "Demetrius has received a good testimony from everyone, and from the truth itself; and we also bear witness, and you know that our witness is

true." Reading those words is soothing to the spirit. The presence of truth can bring calm and peace to our souls.

Especially, when we have been broken, we need the healing balm truth can bring. When we're grieving, we are vulnerable to falsehood the enemy wants to perpetrate on us, particularly actions that we could take to dull our pain, like isolation or using alcohol

and drugs; like focusing on blaming someone for our hurt or for how someone might be treating us in our grief. But, the Bible is filled with truth, and, with it, hope—hope for dealing with today's pain and hope for tomorrow's redemption from this painful world.

When we're hurting we especially need to get into the Word of God and permit the Word of God and its truth to get into us.

Jesus said, in John 14:6, "I am the Way, the TRUTH and the Life." Run to Him in your heartache!

→ he magnitude of the faithfulness of God can never be overstated. The ministry of BASIS is one testimony to that truth. BASIS was founded in 1981, out of the heart of a dear servant of God, Shirley Cook. Shirley never married, never had a child, never lost a child yet God gave her the courage to begin a ministry that was totally out of her area of experience or expertise. She began a support group ministry to five bereaved moms, and God has continued to grow that ministry to this day. Through the years, BASIS has been privileged to touch the lives of many hundreds of families, hurting because they experienced the death of a child. Currently, 500 families are actively involved in

BASIS through the various ministries we provide. Attending support groups, receiving the *RENEW* Newsletter, requesting resources and writing or receiving personal notes of encouragement that acknowledge the birthday and anniversary of the death date of their child are among the ways we reach out to bereaved parents.

Since Shirley served as the first Director of BASIS, God has continued to provide just the right leadership for the ministry. Judy Blore, then Don Allison followed Shirley and God blessed the ministry abundantly through them. When Don retired, I had the privilege to step into the position of Interim Director of BASIS. And, in



His faithfulness, God has been preparing the next Director of BASIS: Dan Steinman.

Dan is a man who loves God with all his heart; a man who, along with his wife, Phyllis, knows the heartache of losing a son; a man filled with compassion toward others who hurt; and a man who is highly motivated to reach out to share in those hurts.
