
to Richard and the clock, very insistent, even signing, 'Please.' Finally, this evening he wrote, 'Richard bag.' He wanted his papers from Bible club that got left in Richard's car!

"The papers were retrieved, and Ray's first priority was to show me the Gospel wheel. [A tool developed by H*VMI to share the Gospel using pictures.] We 'talked' through it, and he was very animated and wanted to pray! I think he may understand!!!!! We also made the cross craft and hung it in the window.

"Richard reported that Ray made him tear up a little because when the Gospel was presented, Ray wrote 'Grampa!' His memory is good, and he was spot on in connecting heaven with where grampa is, just like we hoped he would!

"Could it be that God would give me an extra special blessing that Ray would understand and say, 'YES!' to Jesus 20 years TO THE DAY after I did? July 9, 2000 was when God broke through to me and I accepted [His gift] of salvation. Just having Ray's name in the Book of Life would be enough, but to share the Birthday with him?! Talk about exceeding abundantly more than I can think! I will continue to talk to Ray about it and watch for

> fruit, but I am writing July 9, 2020 in his Bible. We serve such a caring, wonderful Father. Please keep praying for Ray for even deeper understanding and a fruitful life. Thank you so much for your ministry and for faithfully presenting the Gospel. You may have added another crown to your reward!"
